A **book launch** for Hap Wilson's newly released book, *The Cabin: A Search for Personal Sanctuary*, will be held in Hull at **La Cabane en bois rond** on **Wednesday, November 30**, 2005. Books available for sale. **Hap Wilson** will present a slide show and sign books; **Ian Tamblyn** will be singing and selling his new CD.

**Hap Wilson**, artist, author and adventurer, is perhaps best known for his ecotourism/travel guidebooks. He has led over 300 wilderness expeditions in Canada, and served as Pierce Brosnan's personal outdoor trainer for the feature film *Grey Owl*.

**Directions from Ottawa at King Edward Ave.:** Take King Edward Ave., cross the Macdonald Cartier Bridge and continue on Route 5, take the Mont-Bleu exit (Exit 5-S) and turn right onto Mont Bleu Blvd., follow it until the end (about 2.5 km) where you will reach a set of lights and turn left onto Cité-des-Jeunes, go a block and half, La Cabane en bois rond is on the right at 331 Cité-des-Jeunes Blvd., very close to CEGEP L'Outaouais.

**Directions from Ottawa, taking the Champlain Bridge:** After crossing over to Quebec from the Champlain Bridge, go to the second set of lights and turn right onto Taché Blvd., go to the first set of lights and turn left onto St. Raymond Blvd., and go for about four km, then turn left onto Cité-des-Jeunes Blvd., go for about one and half kilometres and the La Cabane en bois rond will be on your left at 331 Cité-des-Jeunes Blvd.

**La Cabane en bois rond** is very close to where the annual ski run leaves from Keskinada.
